Locating Electronic Resources

Open Internet

- Website Authority
 - Authorship, Responsibility, Content, Dates, Navigation/Quality
- Google, Google Images & Google Scholar
 - Other search engines, Metacrawler.com, Dogpile.com, Bing.com, Ask.com
- Editorial control & copyright issues

Databases (full-text, informational, bibliographic)

- Searching (word counting vs. site hits vs. other algorithms)
- Boolean searching (AND, OR, NOT)
- Medical Literature (Medline)
- What's Available? Years, formats, vendors, i.e. Ovid, PubMed
- Nursing Literature (CINAHL, HealthSource Nursing (<u>www.inspire.in.gov</u>)
- National Practice Guideline Clearinghouse

Journals (Print or Electronic)

- Peer Reviewed/Refereed
- Other Literature (Meeting Abstracts, Book Chapters, Technical Reports) (Google Scholar)

- Full-Text Electronic Journals are located on the library homepage under <u>A-Z Journals</u> on the toolbar
- To locate print books and journals search IUCAT on the toolbar
